



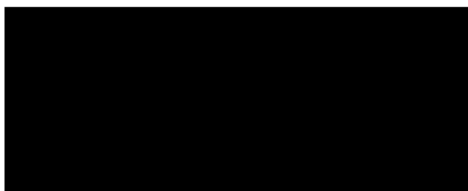

**SUBJECT:** Source Approval Sanctuary Springs Well No. 201, WSSN 20390-54

The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Water Bureau (WB), in conjunction with District Health Department No. 10 (DHD No. 10) has inspected the above named well and appurtenances for use as a noncommunity public water supply and a source for bottling water. The completed sanitary survey and report (required every five years) was transmitted under separate cover on June 21, 2007.

Source 201 is located at the Sanctuary site in section 5 of Morton Township, Mecosta County. This source was initially approved for use by the public as a nontransient noncommunity water supply / bottled water source via the completed sanitary survey report and approval from DHD No. 10 on March 27, 2003. The DEQ, WB, concurred with this report and approval, however, did not issue a separate source approval letter at that time due to an oversight. In conjunction with the recently completed sanitary survey of the source, formal source approval for bottling water is hereby issued. By copy of this letter, the DEQ is notifying the MDA of this issue.
